Course fees

The overall CICM fees are a combination of the CICM fees and the yearly fee paid to Kingston University. For the course commencing September 2012, the CICM fees for year 1 will be **£5,500** and currently the fees per student paid to Kingston University are £500 per annum, a total of £6000.

However, Kingston are currently adjusting their fees to collaborative colleges. We know that ultimately the Kingston University fee could be as high as £1200, which is an overall fee of £6700. This would still be lower than most proposed university courses. However we are hopeful that we can negotiate a significantly lower figure and this figure will be the same for the duration of the course. The overall fee for the September '12 intake will therefore be between **£6000** and **£6700**. As soon as this is resolved we will post the fees on our website.

Fees for Year 2 will be the same as for Year 1 with similar options for extended payment.

In year 3 the number of College hours is much higher and the increase of your fees reflects this. Fees for the theory and clinical training in the third year are **£8,250** plus the fee to Kingston University as outlined above.

Although fees remain the same for Years 1 and 2 the College reserves the right to raise Year 3 fees by up to 10% depending on the rate of inflation.

Applicants who do not have a degree may be eligible for a student loan.
