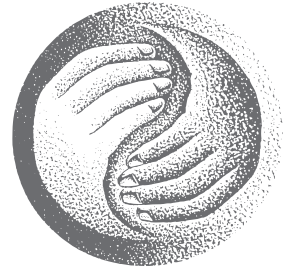

Fees and Applying

The fee for each year is £3400. We are able to offer a £200 per year discount to graduates of the College's Patent Herbal Medicines course as you will need to transition into full herbal practitioner status to continue to use any herbs. This amount may be deducted from the second payment in each year.

To apply please use the application form for this course. The application form is available on line or printed from the college. Please complete all the questions and return it to the registrar with your application fee of £50. As soon as you are accepted, you will be asked to send a non-refundable deposit of £400 to confirm your place.

The remainder of your fees must be paid in two instalments. The first is for £1250 (£1700 less your deposit of £400 and your application fee of £50) and must be made by August 1, 2012. The second is for £1700 and is due on April 1, 2013. For you to attend the course we must have both these cheques by August 1, 2012 and they are non-refundable. Or you may make the deposit and a single whole year payment online.

In the second year, the fees are paid in two cheques of £1700 each. One cheque must be dated August 1, 2013 and the other dated April 1, 2014. Alternatively one payment may be made online.
