

# Course fees

For the course commencing November 2008 the fees for the *first year* will be £5,250 (basic fees of £4,975 plus £275 for Kingston University charges). In the first year this consists of a £50 application fee, a £400 non-refundable deposit, and the balance of £4,800. The balance can be paid in one of three ways:

- 1) a **single payment** of £4,680 (allowing a discount of £120) due by 30 September 2008, or
- 2) **half** (£2,400) by 30 September 2008, plus **two post-dated cheques** for £1,200 each, one dated 31 May 2009 and one dated 31 August 2009, or
- 3) **half** (£2,400) by 30 September 2008, plus a bank **standing order** for ten monthly payments of £240 each, commencing on 1 December 2008.

Fees for the *second year* will be the same as for the first year – that is £5,250, with the same three alternative payment methods.

Fees for the *third 'year'* (actually a period of about 18 months) will be calculated pro rata on a time basis in relation to those for the first two years. They will include any additional charges needed to cover increased cost of living, clinical hours or other unforeseen costs. It is our intention to keep any such increases to a minimum. Fees for the first nine months of the final 'year' will be charged and collected on a basis similar to years 1 and 2, followed by a final invoice for the last nine months of the course.
